- 2. Minutes:** approved January 13, 2021 meeting minutes.
- 3. Guest Presentation: Monica Mount, Dismissal Procedures**
 - a. Presented options to ease the human and vehicular traffic-bottleneck and increase the safety of kids during pickup.

 - a. **Fundraising (Cheryl)**
 - i. Fundraising Night scheduled at Blofish Sushi (owned by Foothill Family) on Tuesday, March 16
 - b. **Community (Maria)**
 - i. Bingo Update: 15 families participated, prizes have been delivered from previous Bingo event.
 - ii. Heritage Night: Planned to kick off in March. 5-7 minute long videos will be sent to kids/families every Monday. Themes/subjects: food, dance and music, games, art (make flags), Stories with help from Boulder Public Library. Karla will work with Maria to help her with contacts and to obtain videos similar to the ones she got for the Museum of Boulder event.
 - iii. Talent Show: April 2 or 9. Shari Polis is on board. Kids will send in 60 second videos.
 - c. **Treasurer (Brian)**
 - i. **Fund the Fox**
 1. \$1300 came in since the last meeting (corporate matching from QualComm and Xilinx)
 2. \$76,491 raised so far
 3. \$34,000 was disbursed to the school and \$832 for Garden to Table program fees.
 4. So we currently have \$41,659 remaining to disburse to the school this spring.
 - ii. **Other fundraising notes**
 1. Original Works raised \$1212 (vs. \$1500 budgeted)

- a. Another Art Fundraiser will be planned by Suzanne Whitman
 - 2. King Soopers sent us \$202, bringing our grocery giveback total to \$812 (most of the way toward our \$1000 budgeted)
- iii. **Spending**
 - 1. Paid the last bills for spirit wear. In total we spent \$1699. We raised \$2100, so after subtracting sales tax and the cost of goods, we netted about \$300.
 - 2. Paid \$499 for staff appreciation lunch, leaving \$501 in our “conference meals” budget.
 - 3. Paid \$357 for bingo prizes.
